• Hurricane Debby

- NRCS Madison would like for the Madison County Soil and Water Board to have a discussion in the minutes of the meeting to discuss damage that has been reported or seen to or by the board members of damage from Hurricane Debby. This will be used by NRCS to develop a report that will be turned into FSA to help them determine the need for emergency assistance in our area.
- O Reports received by DOF and NRCS have been far less than we had with Idalia but it seems that isolated pockets were worse than others. Many reports have come back that on average of reports of forestry damage was in the ballpark of 5% with Debby with downed trees.

Program Deadlines

 USDA-NRCS cost share programs deadline for 2025 have been set for application for November 1st, 2025. This deadline is good for all programs.
